and no one seemed to care.

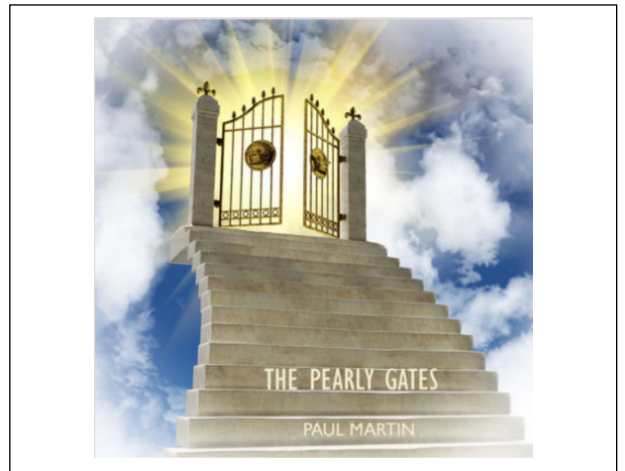
St. Peter said, you must go back,
